Birds of the banks of the Guadalquivir River as they pass through Mengibar. More than 200 different species in a territory that is the crossroads of migratory routes. Apart from the native birds, in spring and summer migratory birds from Africa are observed and in autumn and winter those from northern Europe are also seen. The walk through Finca Badenes offers an excellent opportunity for birdwatching. Among these we can see raptors such as eagles or kestrels, aquatic birds or insectivore birds, among others.

Without a doubt, birds are the easiest group of our fauna to observe, especially if we walk discreetly and try not to expose ourselves. Some binoculars will facilitate the task. At certain times its song will go with us all the way.
